NOTES

These tables attempt to duplicate the probabilities for encounters found in **DUNGEON MASTERS GUIDE** on pages 47 and 190. Instead of rolling a specific chance of encounter (e.g., a 1 on a d12) many times per day the DM simply needs to roll 1d20 to find how long the party is able to travel (or camp) before the next encounter. As shown on page 47 of the **DUNGEON MASTERS GUIDE**, each day is divided into six periods, with days starting at sunrise:

Morning Noon Evening Night Midnight Pre-dawn

Roll once when an adventure begins and then roll again each time an encounter is resolved or the terrain changes. For example, a party setting out on Monday in the morning by boat to travel down the coast rolls an 6. The first encounter would be in the noon period of Wednesday. If they instead turn up a river mouth in the pre-dawn period of Tuesday then that encounter will be scrapped and a new roll made for fresh water; a roll of 1 would indicate a pre-dawn encounter on the river, and a 12 that the next encounter will be around midnight on Sunday.

The terrain type used should be at the scale of five or more miles, rather than individual one-mile or smaller hexes. If the party is attempting a detailed exploration of an area, then use the tables as presented in the book instead of these.

Note that in dense or sparsely populated areas 25% of encounters (1-5 on d20) are with a patrol and in uninhabited areas 5% involve a fortress. See **DUNGEON MASTERS GUIDE** p182.
